BRONZE MORGAN MEMORIAL STATUETTE

The Morgan Statue
Foundation recently
donated a bronze
Morgan memorial
statuette to the British
Motor Museum and
£22,117 of its remaining
funds to the British Motor
Industry Heritage Trust
(BMIHT).

The statuette named 'Handing Over' was sculpted by Leslie Johnson, FRBS, one of the UK's best contemporary figurative sculptors. It shows Morgan founder H.F.S. Morgan standing alongside a 1958 Morgan 4/4, handing the key to his son Peter 'sitting at the wheel', the same year he handed him control of the company, Introduced in 1936, the Morgan 4/4 is still in production today, over 80 years later. The iconic shape of the current Morgan

has not changed for over 60 years, a record unequalled by any othe car manufacturer in the world.

Stephen Laing, Curator the British Motor Museum said "We are delighted to receive this unique statuette in memory of Morgan's Founder and for their generous donation which will help continue the valuable work of BMIHT. The statuette will now be on display in the motorsport section of the Museum for our visitors the enjoy".
